

LCHS PROM DRESS CODE—PER GISD GUIDELINES

The following dress code and expectations will be enforced at all LCHS dances. Guidelines for dress will also be posted on the school's website. If the attire is questionable, students are encouraged to show their evening wear to the administrators beforehand to determine if it is appropriate for the dance.

A date or guest of an LCHS student attending a LCHS school dance must be at least a high school-aged student. If an LCHS student's date is not an LCHS student (from another school), it is the responsibility of the LCHS student to inform his or her date that the required dress code and behavior codes will apply to the date as well. Prior approval from administration must be obtained for non LCHS students to attend and the proper paperwork filled out.

Girls will wear formal gowns or pantsuits. Strapless and spaghetti straps will be permitted.

Reminders:

- Dresses are to be no more than 2 inches above the knee (front and back). This also applies to slits in dresses. Dress must also be at the appropriate length even if leggings are worn underneath the dress.
- Dress may not be extremely low cut in the front or back. The front of the dress must not fall below the bra line; the back of the dress must not fall below the waist.
- Dresses may not be extremely tight/form fitting. Be aware of the material that gathers and rises when you walk.

The following will not be permitted:

- Two piece formal gowns or pants and top, where the midriff is showing
- Dresses with revealing cut outs
- See through gowns (this includes sheer/mesh overlays that do not have material underneath)
- Shorts
- Torn clothing

Boys are encouraged to wear a suit or sports coat. Torn clothing will not be permitted. Ties are encouraged, but not required.

All students:

If the attire is questionable, students are encouraged to show their evening wear to administrators beforehand to determine if it is dance appropriate.

The determination of the appropriateness of student dress and grooming shall rest with the principal/assistant principals. Students and their dates who are non-compliant with the dress code will not be admitted to the dance or will be escorted out of the dance. No refunds will be given for dance dress code infractions in which these students are asked to leave.
