

ROWLETT HIGH SCHOOL REGISTRATION INFORMATION

2010-2011

It is important for all students to register if you believe you may not be clear to receive a schedule on the first day of school. If you owe for fines or textbooks, or if your immunization record is not current, you will not have a schedule on the first day of school, and you will be sent to the gym until you are clear to receive your schedule. Students who were notified in the spring about immunizations due over the summer must take care of this prior to the first day of school, per state law. Only students who desire a parking space, or who are not cleared for fines or immunizations to receive a schedule the first day, need to be at registration. **Each grade level will be assigned a certain time for registration.**

Ninth grade students are invited to attend **Flight School**, and this time will also be used to take care of registration needs for the ninth graders. Flight School is a special orientation for ninth graders and will be held on Thursday, August 12, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. All ninth graders are invited. There is an optional \$15 cost which is for a maroon T-shirt, folders, and pencils (students must wear a solid maroon shirt to attend pep rallies, so it is a good idea to get this t-shirt now). Freshmen are not required to attend "Flight School," but it is strongly recommended, and attending will make the jump into high school easier. Please send check or money order, payable to Rowlett HS, to RHS Flight School, attn: Melissa Downs, 4700 Kirby Rd., Rowlett, TX 75088. **The deadline is Monday, August 2, 2010 and the envelope you send must be post marked by this date. If you register after this date, there will be a \$5 late registration fee if you ordered a T-Shirt, and you will be notified of the fee.** There will be a separate line at Flight School for those who registered late. Those who have paid for flight school by the deadline will be assigned to a group and this can be confirmed by looking on the website.

PARKING REGISTRATION SCHEDULE

Students will have the opportunity to purchase a parking permit, if they qualify, based on good attendance from the prior school year and having no fines. The Seniors with perfect attendance, from 3rd term Junior year, will receive theirs first. In order to receive a parking permit, students must have a valid Texas driver's license (or will have it by Sept. 1st), proof of insurance, and all the information for the vehicle being registered. In addition, students should have cleared all fines owed to the school or any other school, by the May deadline, and immunizations are to be current. The parking permit is \$20 for the school year and is non-refundable and non-transferable. In order to retain this parking space, regular attendance is required. If a student appears on any "Loss of Credit" list or is consistently late throughout the year, or is repeatedly in violation of school rules, the student will be in jeopardy of losing their assigned parking space.

The only change in the parking system is that students with perfect attendance from 3rd term in the 11th and 12th grade will be the first group to register in their respective grades. They will be able to select their space. Those students on the Loss of Credit 3rd term and **who made up time** to restore all credits and paid in full will be in the last group to register.

We will be using the same system of selling parking permits as we did last summer. The procedure is attached. Please make sure that you read the information carefully.
