

New This Year: Required Student ID Cards for 2010-2011

- These will be issued during the first week of school (possible to be done through advisory class first day)
- ID's are to be worn daily and should be visible at all times
- Last year pictures will be rolled over to this year (once we have new pictures made ID's can be updated)
- New students will have their pictures made when enrolling and the ID can be printed then (this will be part of the enrollment process)
- When a student withdraws we will collect student ID in the procedure.
- Each student will receive a lanyard (may use their own appropriate one if they choose to do so) and 1 ID free of charge
- Students needing replacement ID's will be charged \$2 the first time, and \$5 for each time after
- The consequences for not wearing your ID will be as follows:
 1. 1st offense: Referral issued-replacement will be awarded with no consequence other than the monetary value set
 2. 2nd offense-Wednesday School will be issued along with the monetary fine
 3. 3rd offense-RAC, with monetary fine, no exemptions
 4. 4th offense-RAC, with monetary fine, loss of privilege list for the remainder of the year
- Data base will be kept for those students who always have their ID's; there will be a drawing at the end of each grading period and term for a "prize". Two per grade level per grading cycle.

Since this is a new policy, we will begin the procedure as soon as most students have their school ID or a temporary one. At that time, the consequences will go into effect. We will "practice" first and then let the students and parents know the official start date.
