School counselors are vital members of the education team and maximize student success.

Help all students:

- Apply academic achievement strategies
- Manage emotions and apply interpersonal skills
- Plan for postsecondary options (College, Career, Military)

Appropriate duties include providing:

- Individual student academic planning and goalsetting
- School counseling classroom instruction based on student success standards
- Short-term counseling
- Referrals for long-term counseling support
- Collaboration with families/teachers/administrators/community for student success
- Advocacy for students at individual education plan meetings and other student-focused meetings
- Data analysis to identify student issues, needs and challenges

Remember: everyone in the classroom has a story that leads to misbehavior or defiance. 9 times out of 10, the story behind the misbehavior won't make you angry.


