You must do the following: \*(and are subject to change)

- 1. GPA 3.5
- 2. 15 community service hours over the summer in order to apply for National Honor Society

- a. Opportunities include:
  - i. Freshman Orientation
    - ii. Volunteer- (Libraries, Schools, Tutoring, Churches, Food Banks, Hospitals)
    - iii. Parent Provided Service Hours (no more than 2 hours per week)
- 4. Once returning in August, there is an application process. To submit an application, the above mentioned have to accompany your application. (15 Community service hours from the Summer, 3.5 GPA)
- 5. Yearly Requirements
  - a. 75 total hours (may include 15 from the summer)-30 hours MUST BE NHS sponsored activities. You must have at least 20 hours by the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester.

Must have at least 30 NHS sponsored hours.

- b. Members will keep track of hours on NHS Hours Log. Logs will be turned in on the NHS Board outside of 2113 in a folder. Hours must be turned in within the same month of acquiring them or your hours WILL NOT BE COUNTED.
- c. General Meetings will be MANDATORY unless attending a school sponsored event. YOU MUST wear your NHS shirt and have your ID.
- d. Your GPA must remain 3.5 or higher
- e. Probation will be given if hours are not met at the end of the semester or if GPA drops.
- f. Social media will be watched closely. Postings that are unacceptable or inappropriate will be grounds for probation and/or dismissal.
