# **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

**LINE CAMP:** This is mandatory... if you do not attend Line Camp you will not perform during the football season. Camp is where the girls learn all the material for their performances. The summer practices are also mandatory. Please make sure you schedule your summer activities around these dates.

**ABSENCES:** The only excused absences are: personal illness, death in family, illness in family that requires out-of-town travel, funeral, mandatory court appearance, and religious holidays. It is very important that you understand if you miss any day the week of a game/performance you will be out for that performance/game, no matter if it is unexcused or excused.

**PRACTICES:** Lariat practices are held on Tuesdays and Wednesdays after school. Please make arrangements now for any doctor and dentist appointments to be scheduled on days other than these, or after practices.

**JV GAMES:** Lariats perform at all in-district (Garland, Rowlett, and Sachse, etc.) JV games on Wednesday or Thursday nights.

**VARSITY GAMES**: The Lariats are required to attend some Varsity games. A schedule of required games will be given out at Line Camp. We participate in Pre-Game with Varsity Drill Team. Auditions for Pre-Game are held prior to each Varsity game we attend.

**TRANSPORTATION:** You are responsible for taking and picking up your Lariat from all games. We do not ride buses to any of the games. I will stay a maximum of 30 minutes after the game; any girls left past this time lose the right to perform at the next game.

**ARRIVAL TIMES:** The Lariats will arrive to each game 30 minutes to an hour before the game start time. Please make arrangements to be there on time. If you need to arrange for a ride, take care of that in advance. <u>Lariats must be on time.</u> As the Constitution states, an absence is recorded if the Drill Team member is 20 minutes late. You are counted tardy and will receive 1 demerit for being up until 20 minutes. After 20 minutes, it is then counted as an absence and 10 demerits will be given.

#### Grades

You are required to get THREE teacher recommendations. ### Tryout Wear

- Practice days you may wear any dance wear you choose (example: tanks, jazz pants, dance shorts if you have tights on, jazz shoes or foot paws).
- NO shorts unless you have tights underneath.
- Hair must be in a low slicked (gel and hairspray) back ponytail, parted on the left side no whispies.

### Tryout Day Outfit

- Black turtle neck long sleeve leotard (can be purchased at Special Effects, Sandys, Texas Motion Sports etc.)
- Black Hot Shorts No logos.
- Jazz Shoes (no tennis shoes or sneakers) You may wear tan half paws or tan or black jazz shoes.
- Tan tights our team tights can be purchased at Special Effects in Rockwall Body Wrappers - Jazzy Tan.
- Hair will be worn in a high sock bun. We will demonstrate how to use the sock bun during the clinic. You will need a sponge donut roller, bobby pins, hairnet and a lot of gel.
- Heavy makeup and Red Lipstick (Love That Red by Revlon is our team color).
- No earrings or hairpieces are allowed.

# **General Tryout Information**

Tryouts are closed: parents, friends, or anyone not trying out are NOT allowed in the school during Tryouts.

If someone would like to watch they may come on Thursday to Mock Tryouts, which are open to everyone. Video devices are not allowed during Mock Tryouts.

# **Timeline for Officer Tryouts**

Tryouts will begin at 5:00 pm.

Candidates will interview one at a time with the judges.

In groups of 2 or 3 the candidates will perform the Jazz routine.

In groups of 3 or 4 the candidates will perform the Strut routine as well as right and left splits.

Call backs for either routine may be required, per the judge's request.

Tryouts usually last approximately 2 hours depending on the number of candidates. I will send a "Remind 10"1 text out to parents who subscribe and let you know when we are close to being done so that you know when to head back up to the school.

To join the "Remind 101" group, text 81010 and in the message type @c7ddde.

After tryouts are over all candidates will remain inside the school until the judges are dismissed. Each girl will be given an envelope with a letter from the Director stating if they were selected as an Officer for the 2018-2019 year. They may open these envelopes anywhere they choose **outside** of the school. If a congratulations letter is received, the candidate is to return to the gym with their parents and friends for our traditional ceremony to say farewell to the old Officers and to induct in the new Officers by disclosing their rank.
