#### Selected students must:

- 1. Complete and sign the **Student Activity form**.
- 2. Read and sign the **Membership Expectation letter**.
- 3. Turn in <u>3 Forms of Recommendation</u> (see attached) 2 must be completed by GISD teachers. One must be a current teacher. The third form must be completed by an adult (not a parent or guardian) who <u>is not</u> a GISD employee.
- 4. All forms must be handed in a sealed large manila envelope. The student's name, grade, and ID# should be clearly written on the front of the envelope.
- 5. <u>All envelopes containing the forms must be handed in to Mrs. Haggard in room 804 by Friday.</u>
  August 30<sup>th</sup> at 4:00pm. (No late forms will be accepted.)
- 6. A copy of the student's final report card from previous year must be submitted. This may be obtained from the front office if necessary.
- 7. Students must include **\$20** for dues & t-shirt fees preferably in cash, or you can make out a check to Schrade Middle School.
- 8. Forms will then be submitted to the selection committee who will select the students to be fully inducted into the Schrade Middle School National Junior Honor Society.
- 9. Induction is scheduled for Wednesday, September 18th from 6-7pm in the Schrade Cafeteria.

Dear NJHS Member and Parent(s):

We are excited that you have qualified academically to apply for membership in the Schrade Middle School National Junior Honor Society. We would like to take the opportunity to explain the expectations for NJHS members during this school year.

All members are expected to:

- 1. Uphold each of the five characteristics expected of an NJHS member at <u>ALL</u> times.
- 2. **Attend all monthly meetings**. Meetings are generally the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of the month from 4-4:30pm. If a member cannot attend a meeting, they must promptly submit a written or emailed excuse as to why the meeting was missed. Oftentimes sports or other responsibilities require your presence elsewhere, but keep in mind that you also have a responsibility as an active NJHS member.
- 3. Maintain a high academic standard and submit grade reports each six weeks, signed by a parent. An **overall GPA of 93 must be maintained**. If you fall below a 93, you will be put on academic probation for the current grading cycle. Grade sheets will be submitted each grading cycle for verification.
- 4. Volunteer **10 hours** of community service **PER SEMESTER**. Additionally, NJHS members are expected to participate in the NJHS chosen community service project(s). All community and NJHS service must be documented within the current academic year and will be done so digitally, through Google Classroom.
- 5. Be prompt to all meetings and participate in a mature manner. Any behavior that disrupts the meeting environment will not be tolerated. As the year progresses, meetings generally do not take more than 20 minutes; however, late and disruptive members can prolong meeting times.

These expectations help to continue Schrade's strong NJHS tradition.

Any member who does not exemplify these expectations may be placed on probation or asked to resign
It is our goal to ensure that all members uphold the five characteristics of NJHS members.
